

The Association of Chinese Americans will be starting a "Daily Conversation" & "Citizenship" class on the second week of October and will be ending in May. Both classes will be taught with Mandarin translations at the Chinese Community Center during the afternoon from 1-3pm and the registration fee will be \$40 (\$30 for ACA members) which includes class materials.

1. Daily conversation: covers all the basics that is needed to have daily conversations. We will cover all the basic phrases and terminologies and afterwards, supplemental materials will be provided through the student's needs.

2. Citizenship: split into two sections (N400 & 100 Questions). As I've just held a N400 class over the summer we will be starting with the 100 Questions and Liqun will be the one teaching it.

- 100 Questions: we will provide the book & CD along with a Chinese translation of the 100 Questions. The main purpose of this course is to help the students understand the questions and also make any necessary changes such as the President, State rep. etc. In regards of the testing, the students just have to memorize the 100 Questions and there won't be any variations.

- N400: we will provide the updated form along with a Chinese translation. The main purpose of this course is to also help the students understand the content but also to make sure they're filling in everything they're supposed to and correctly. In regards of the testing, the content of the form will be asked in order however there are many ways one can ask for the information (i.e. What is your name, last name, full name, family name, etc.). We will be mainly concentrating on the testing portion to show students the different variations.
